The Overview of Zhejiang Gongshang University





- Located in Hangzhou 杭州, Zhejiang Province.
- Established in 1911 as Hangzhou Business School

Degree Programs in English

International students, including exchange students from partner universities with insufficient Chinese language skills can apply for degree programs (from Bachelor to Doctor) in the areas of Finance, Accounting, E-commerce, International Business, Economic Statistics, Computer Science and Technology, Law, Art Design, Environmental Science, Food Science, etc. However, they are required to take some courses in Chinese language and business culture (in English).

Tuition range 18,000-28,000 RMB per year



Chinese Language & Culture

The program is designed for students of Chinese language learning, including Essential Chinese Language, Intermediate Business Language, Advanced Chinese Language, Business Chinese, Understanding China and other courses. The courses are offered both at downtown campus and Xiasha campus.



China & Chinese Business

The program is designed for students majoring in business or relevant academic subjects, and other international personnel who are interested in China and Chinese market. The courses are delivered in English. The duration of the program could be for a few months or one year depending on the requirement of the target group. It aims to enable students to be familiar with China's economic, social and cultural development, China's economic policies and regulations. Chinese business environment and Chinese enterprise culture and so on. The major courses include: Chinese society and Culture, China's Contemporary Economy and Trade, Business Practices in China, Oriental Management, Business Law of China and Chinese Language. The program is offered to the group of 10 people or more, and the courses could be tailored according to the specific requirement.

- The authorities utilized new application Ding Talk for monitoring health conditions of university staff and students.
- Ding Talk is an working platform developed by Alibaba Group. All members are required to report their health condition every morning.
- All members installed this app into their phones, that means we are ready to perform Online teaching.
 - ⇒ The subsequent difficulty is teachers need to get familiar with this application for teaching.

- The university quickly established a supporting system.
- Appointing graduate students as assistants for each lecture to support teachers (setting up new virtual class room and inviting students into new room).
- Before lectures started, teachers had almost nothing to do.

problems of online teaching.

- 1. Some foreign teachers have to hold classes in the middle of the night due to time difference.
- 2. There are difficulties to have interactive teaching, such as conversation practices.
- It is impossible to instruct students standing by them directly on writing order of foreign writing system (e.g. Hiragana in Japanese).
- 4. Copy right concern about teaching materials.
- 5. Correct answers of exercises can be known to students.






 Japan Foundation performs a statistic survey once per three years. The result shows Japanese learners in China increased 5.4% from 2015 to 2018.

4. 学習者数 2)地域別増減及び上位10か国・地域








 The number of the Japanese major in Chinese universities, in fact, does not increase, and almost all universities substantially reduce new students in the Japanese major.

Too Many Japanese Majors in China and Excess Human Resource Supply



 As a result, college graduates from the Japanese major face severe challenges. Because of excessive competition, Japanese language translators and interpreters in company are struggling with lower salary than other general work.

• In case of Wuhan, a big city in middle China, avarage starting salary is around 5,000 RMB/m, but 3,500 RMB/m for Japanese-related positions. Some of graduates cannot abandon Japanese so that they accept low salaries.



 Many students in my department take sub-major, such as marketing, microeconomics, etc.

 One solution may be to provide students working opportunities in Japan after graduation.

 Internship is also very helpful for them, but students only can apply internships in Japan through agents with paying 1500 US dollars or more. So, it would be great if exchange students can find internship/job opportunities during their stay in Japan.



• Students in the Japanese major can achieve intermediate level of Japanese after two-years learning.

 Some students go to North America or UK to improve their English. We hope more students to go abroad. It would be great if we can provide a wide range of oversea studying opportunities, not only in English speaking countries.
