### **MMU STUDENTS JOIN** STUDENT EXCHANGE **PROGRAMME IN INDONESIA**

Outbound **Mobility Programmes** 



A total of 20 students from Faculty of Creative Multimedia (FCM) and Faculty of Information Science and Technology (FIST) participated in Student Exchange Programme 2018 at Widyatama Universitas, Indonesia for two weeks. The students were accompanied by Ms Sri Kusumawati Mohd, Daud, Ms Siti Zainab Ibrahim as academic visiting scholars and Mr Mohd Naiib Osman as accompanied staff.



During the programme, the students were exposed with short courses namely Business Intelligence (BI) and E-commerce by Fakultas Teknik of Widyatama Universitas to the FIST students. The FCM students also experienced two short courses by Fakultas Visual Communication Design in Branding & New Media and Typography Kinetic, where the students were taught on basic typography, the anatomy of the font and many more.

Ms Sri Kusumawati and Ms Zainab were given opportunities to share knowledge and experiences in Bandung. Fakultas Teknik of Widyatama Universitas had organised a public talk session entitled "Research and Innovation (R&I) at MMU FIST Thundercloud Lab". In her talk, Ms Zainab presented research projects and activities that had been conducted and are currently on-going in FIST Thundercloud Lab owned by Center of Intelligent Cloud Computing (CICC). Meanwhile, Ms Sri Kusumawati presented a talk on the topic of "Pendidikan Kreatif Berkelanjutan dalam Bidang Multimedia" at Sekolah Menengah Kejuruan Negeri (SMKN 5), Bandung which was attended by the staff of the school.

It is well acknowledged that this student exchange program provides a unique opportunity for students and staff to acquire knowledge in the international setting of different cultures while exploring new places overseas. At the same time, this program provides a platform for the students and staff of both universities to network and strengthen the existing ties









### **MMU STUDENTS GAIN NEW PERSPECTIVE THROUGH TRIPS AND SEMINARS**

On 2 May 2019, a group of FOB students from Diploma in Accounting witnessed the launching of Malaysia's first ever commodities e-commerce trading platform operated by a Malaysian company, Commodities Global Trade Sdn. Bhd. (CGTSB) that holds the executive rights under Bohai Commodity Exchange of China (BOCE). The event was graced by Prime Minister, YAB Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad in Putrajaya with his remarks that China was Malaysia's largest trading partner for 10 consecutive years. With the establishment of e-commerce platforms backed by the government, cross-border trade becomes safer, more effective and efficient for the businesses. The students and lecturers gained more insights on e-commerce through this educational trip.





Apart from that, a total of 30 students from Diploma in Accounting attended an Industrial Talk delivered by Mr. Faruq Arif Tajul Ariffin, the Vice President/Associate Audit Head-Islamic Banking & Shariah Audit of AmBank Group. The talk expounded on the overview and new updates in the accounting field as well as to encourage them to perform better in their studies. Mr. Faruq shared his 11 years' working experience in the audit field. The talk also benefited newcomers as an eye opener session for them to pursue their career in the field. Also present during the talk were Ms. Nun Shwu Huey, Deputy Dean for Academic and Internationalisation II FOB and lecturers.

Other than that, a total of 13 MMU students attended the Al Sharg Conference at the Royal Chulan Hotel Kuala Lumpur on 1 until 2 May 2019. The conference exposed on artificial intelligence, robotics and other disruptive technologies as a new era of the world. The speakers at this conference were YAB Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, the Prime Minister of Malaysia; John Keane, a Professor of Politics in Sydney University; Rumesya Kadak, a member of Turkish Parliament and many other significant speakers. The students gained more understanding on the importance of embracing transformation for progress and transformation.
