 - 2nd in Elsevier ranking



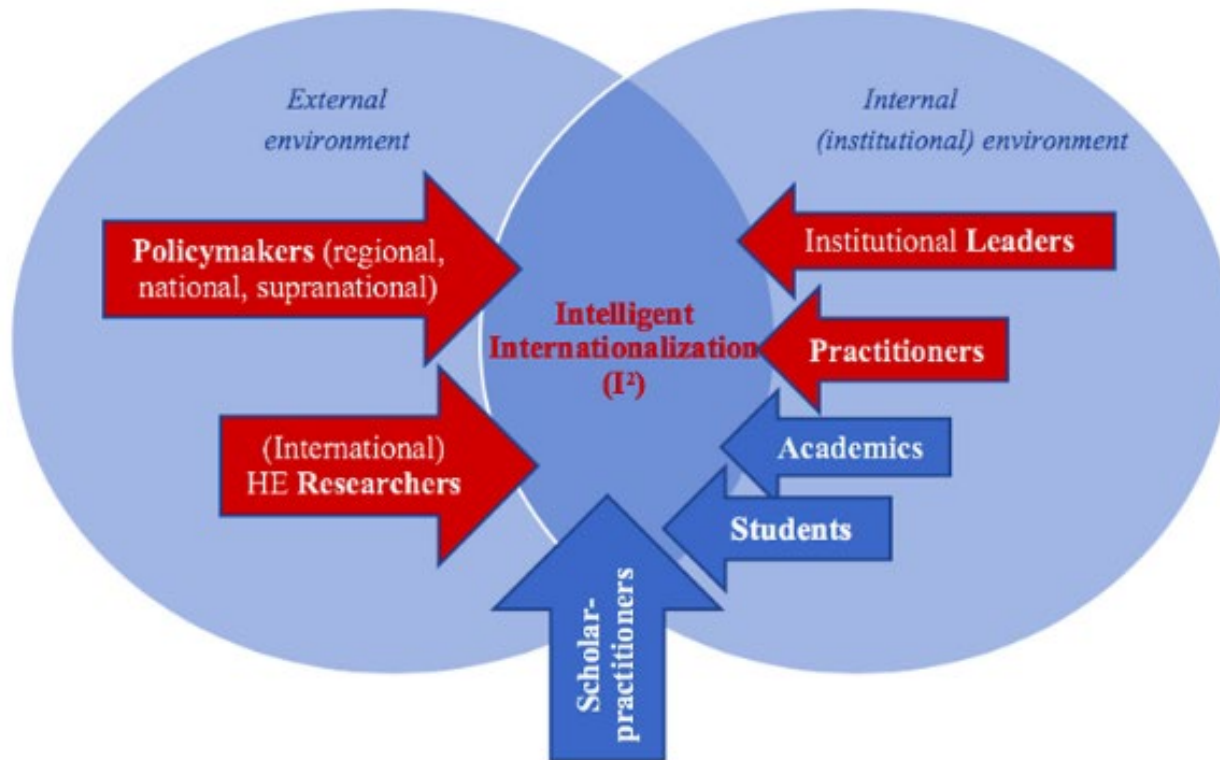

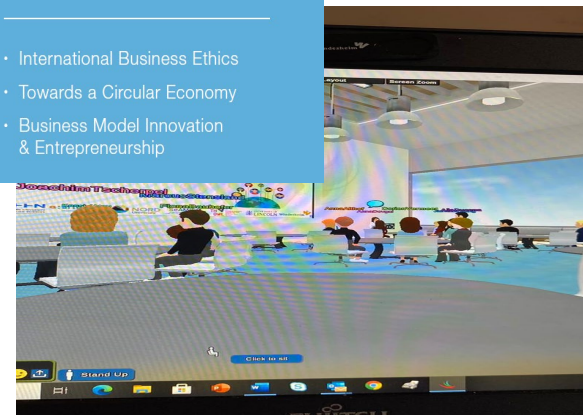
