● Manuela Adreani マヌエラ・アドレアーニ



ローマ生まれ。現在イタリアのトリノ在住。イラストレーション専攻のディプロマを取得後、グラフィックアーティストを経てアニメーションの世界へ入り、IEDトリノ(欧州デザイン研究所)でアニメーションの修士課程の奨学金を獲得した後、市内で最も重要なスタジオの一つである Lastrego e Testa でイタリアのRAIテレビが制作した Le avventure di Aladino(アラジンの冒険)、Amita della Giungla(ジャングルから来たアミータ)

、Carlo Fruttero 原作の La Creazione(天地創造)などのシリーズに携わる。2011 年に挿絵画家として独立し、Benchmark や Scholastic India から作品を発表。ピノキオ生誕 130 周年を記念して開催された挿絵コンテストで受賞。イタリアの White Star Kids Publishing が、韓国、中国、タイ、オーストラリア、アメリカ、ヨーロッパ各地など多くの国や言語で出版したさまざまな物語の挿絵を描くとともに、イタリアの Rizzoli Educational および Mondadori が刊行する学術書の表紙や挿絵を制作。また、イギリスの Lantana Publishing やオーストラリアの Red Paper Kite などの出版社と協働で新作の物語に取り組み、移民や同性愛など現代の問題に関する多様な主題を描く。

Manuela Adreani was born in Rome and now resident in Turin, Italy. After taking a diploma specializing in illustration, she worked as a graphic artist and then progressed to the world of animation. After winning a scholarship for a master course in animation at IED Torino (European Institute of Design), she worked for Lastrego e Testa, one of the most important studios in the city, on TV series produced and broadcast by Italy's RAI television: "Le avventure di Aladino" (*Aladdin*), "Amita della Giungla" (*Amita from the Jungle*), and "La Creazione" (*The Creation*), based on the book by Carlo Fruttero. In 2011 she embarked on a career as a freelance illustrator, working with Benchmark and Scholastic India. She was one of the winners of the illustration contest organized for the 130th anniversary of the creation of Pinocchio. Thereafter she started working with White Star Kids publishing (IT), and illustrated a lot of tales and stories, printed in many countries and languages such as Korea, China, Thailand, Australia, USA, and all around Europe. She also worked with Rizzoli Educational (IT) and Mondadori (IT) creating covers and illustrations for scholar books. With Lantana Publishing (UK) and Red Paper Kite (AUS) she worked on unreleased stories that gave her the opportunity to illustrate different topics, based on contemporary issues such as immigration and homosexuality.

This was a formative time where she became fascinated with the way that illustration can entangle the interior world of dreams and imagination with the real phenomenological world. He has also been interested in the ecology of urban wildlife, especially birds.

Until recently, he was co-editor of the Routledge/ASLE-UKI journal *Green Letters: Studies in Ecocriticism* for 20 years. John has published widely in the environmental humanities, specifically around Victorian literature and ecology, ecomedia, and contemporary fiction. He is currently working on a cultural history of photosynthesis.

● Nobuhiro Suwa 諏訪敦彦



Nobuhiro Suwa is a filmmaker and a professor at the Graduate School of Film and New Media at Tokyo University of the Arts. he directed documentary programs for television, before presenting his first feature film 2/Duo in 1997. He became known for his improvisational approach that does not use written scripts. M/OTHER, his second feature, won the FIPRESCI Award in Cannes. He then moved his filmmaking base to France. His Voices in the Wind won the Special Mention by the International Jury in Generation 14plus at the Berlin International Film Festival in 2019. He has been one of the leading members of "SAVE the CINEMA," the campaign that supports smaller cinemas suffering under the COVID-

19 outbreak, and is also a co-chairperson of "action4cinema," the association to request the establishment of the Japanese version of NCC.

映画監督・東京藝術大学大学院教授。テレビドキュメンタリーの演出を経て、97年初長編「2/デュオ」を発表。完成台本を用いない即興演出が話題となる。99年「M/OTHER」をカンヌ国際映画祭監督週間に出品し国際批評家連盟賞を受賞。その後、映画制作の拠点をフランスに移す。19年「風の電話」が第70回ベルリン国際映画祭ジェネレーション14プラス部門にて国際審査員特別表彰を受けた。コロナ禍によって危機的状況のミニシアターを支援するSAVE the CINEMAの中心メンバーとして活動し、現在は日本版CNC設立を求める会(action4cinema)共同代表を務める。
